

Swanton Morley Cemetery

Memorial Garden

Swanton Morley Parish Council has created a Memorial Garden within Swanton Morley Cemetery for relatives to plant a rose in memory of their loved ones. There is no charge for the planting of roses, however we would ask that the following rules are respected:

1. Only roses can be planted in the memorial garden.
2. Roses should be of a Floribunda or Hybrid Tea variety. The colour can be that of the relatives choosing.
3. Roses should be planted at no lesser distance than 2 feet away from neighbouring roses.
4. Planting of roses must be done with the assistance of one of the following members of the Parish Council.
 - a. Mrs Marilyn Thomas (01362 637944)
 - b. Mr Roger Atterwill (01362 637000)
 - c. Mr Bernie Marsham (01362 637300)

This is to ensure that the protective membrane remains secure and that the rose is well positioned. These members of the council will only be present for a short duration of time for the planting of the rose and will not interfere with any time of reflection you wish to take.

5. An inscribed plaque of a maximum size of 6" x 2" can also be placed with the rose.
6. Please be mindful of other people's roses when planting or tending to your own rose.
7. Swanton Morley Parish Council reserves the right to prune all roses and where necessary reposition or remove roses that are diseased or becoming problematic to other plants.
8. Swanton Morley Parish Council shall not be held responsible for any damage or breakage to roses or plaques which may occur through any cause whatsoever.
